## NOTICE OF RACE

### 2008 SCYC FALL ONE DESIGN SERIES

**AUGUST 23, SEPTEMBER 27, AND OCTOBER 25, 2008**

#### **1 Rules**

- 1.1 The series will be governed by *rules* as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS), the 2008 SCYC Minimum Equipment Requirements (MER) as they apply to category 4 races and the 2008 SCYC Fall One Design Series Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2 US Sailing prescription to RRS 75.3 shall not apply.
- 1.3 The sailing instructions will alter RRS rule 40.1 to require adequate personal buoyancy be worn while racing.

#### **2 Eligibility and Entry**

- 2.1 Santana 22s, Moore 24s, Santa Cruz 27s, A-CAT, and Olson 30s are eligible to participate in this series. Other one-design classes may petition to participate if a minimum of at least three (3) boats are entered by the Competitors meeting.
- 2.2 A boat is not entered until her series fee is paid, the entry form is signed, and there are at least 3 entries for their class.
- 2.3 At least two boats in a class must be in the starting area for that class to be given a warning signal.

#### **3 Fees**

- 3.1 Entry fees for the series are payable to the Santa Cruz Yacht Club. Early entries (\$50) are due at SCYC by 1800 August 22. Regular entries (\$65) will be accepted at the SCYC Club House between 1030 and 1055 hours on August 23. One day entries (\$50) after 1025 hours August 23 will not be eligible for trophies or the Champion of Champions regatta.

#### **4 Schedules**

- 4.1 A competitors meeting will be at 1100 on August 23, 2008 at the SCYC clubhouse.
- 4.2 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is 1255 hours each day.
- 4.3 Nine races are scheduled (except for the Santana 22 where six races are scheduled) as follows:

August 23, 2008	3 races (2 races Santana 22)
September 27, 2008	3 races (2 races Santana 22)
October 25, 2008	3 races (2 races Santana 22)
- 4.4 Six completed races (four for Santana 22) will constitute a series.

#### **5 Sailing Instructions**

- 5.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available at the Competitors meeting.

#### **6 Venue**

- 6.1 Racing will be around temporary inflatable buoys in the north end of Monterey Bay. The racing area will be within a 2.5 mile radius from the Santa Cruz Small Craft Harbor west jetty.

#### **7 Courses**

- 7.1 Course diagrams will be provided with the sailing instructions.

#### **8 Scoring**

- 8.1 When fewer than six races have been completed (four for Santana 22), a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 8.2 When six (four for Santana 22) or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of here race scores excluding her worst score.

#### **9 Prizes**

- 9.1 Boats entered in classes with three (3) or more entries in the regatta are eligible for the Champion of Champions Regatta. Prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the organizing authority.
