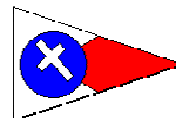

**2009 Santa Cruz Laser NorCals
2009 Santa Cruz 5o5 Spring Regatta
Saturday-Sunday April 4-5, 2009**

1 Rules

- 1.1 This Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2 The 2008-2009 SCYC Minimum Equipment Requirements for Monohulls for Category 5 races will apply.
- 1.3 All competitors are required to wear a personal flotation device while racing even if a "Y" flag is not flown. This changes RRS 40.

2 Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 This is a one-design regatta open to Lasers, Laser Radials and 5o5s.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may register by completing a 2009 Regatta Entry Form (EF) and presenting it to the Santa Cruz Yacht Club. The 2009 EF can be found at the Clubhouse or under Racing at www.scyc.org. Entries must be received by the race committee not later than 1055 hours, April 4, 2009..
- 2.3 A boat is not entered until the entry form is signed and the entry fee is paid.
- 2.4 For full rig Lasers, this will be a qualifying event for the O'Day from Area G. Qualifying boats will be responsible for their own expenses for the O'Day event.

3 Fees

- 3.1 The entry fee of \$30 for Lasers and \$50 for 5o5s is payable to the Santa Cruz Yacht Club.

4 Schedule

- 4.1 Six races are planned, three on Saturday April 4, 2009 and three on Sunday April 5, 2009. A minimum of three races shall constitute a series. No throwouts will be allowed. This changes RRS A2.
- 4.2 A Competitors meeting will be held at 1100 hours on Saturday April 4, 2009 at the SCYC Clubhouse.
- 4.3 The scheduled time of the warning signal is 1255 hours on April 4th.
- 4.4 An Awards Ceremony will take place at the SCYC Clubhouse following the regatta.

5 Sailing Instructions

- 5.1 The Sailing Instructions, including courses to be sailed will be available at the Competitors meeting.

6 Venues

- 6.1 The course will be set using inflatable marks south of the Santa Cruz Harbor in the Monterey Bay.

7 Prizes

- 7.1 Prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the Organizing Authority.
