

REVISED NOTICE OF RACE
"THE DOUBLE ANGLE"

Governed by the *Rules* as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*, and open to all members in good standing of a recognized yacht club. All monohull entries must be self-righting sailing vessels. All vessels must be capable of rigorous ocean passages, and are required to have a self bailing cockpit, a reliable auxiliary, a VHF radio, a crew overboard retrieval system, and comply with the U.S. Coast Guard offshore requirements. Life Jackets must be worn on the entire race course by all participants.

CLASSES

Divisions of class are to be based on total number of early entries. A class start will be given to any class with 5 or more registered boats. There will be two starts, one in Santa Cruz, and one in Monterey. First Warning will be at 1155 hrs for both starts.

REGISTRATION

Entry fee for early registration is \$65.00 if received before September 6th, and should be sent to:

Late entries will be accepted at a cost of \$100.00.

Representatives from E.Y.C. will accept entry forms and fees on the day of the race at the skippers meeting from 11:00 AM to 11:30 AM, at which time the final race instructions will be made available. Skippers meeting will be run by EYC representatives. Santa Cruz and Monterey Yacht Club's race committee will detail the starting procedures and EYC will detail the finish procedures.

POST RACE+ AWARDS

A post race awards ceremony will be held after all boats are docked at EYC. Docking arrangements can be made by calling EYC Port Captain on VHF channel 68. Skippers should be prepared to raft up at the Guest Dock if necessary. Post race festivities will include dinner for \$15, and a party with a rock n roll band. Participants are welcome to stay overnight.
