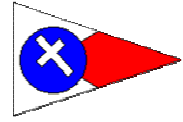

2009 FALL JACK & JILL REGATTA

SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 20, 2009

1 Rules

- 1.1 The series will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the 2008-2009 SCYC Minimum Equipment Requirements (MER) as they apply to category 4 races. The MER document may be found at <http://www.scyc.org> under "Racing".
- 1.2 RRS 40 will be changed to require competitors wear a personal flotation device while racing regardless of whether or not a "Y" flag is flown.

2 Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 This series is open to any boat holding a valid 2009 Monterey Bay PHRF or 2009 BAMA PHRF certificate.
- 2.2 There will be spinnaker and non-spinnaker PHRF divisions and a multi-hull division. Boats racing shall have exactly two persons on board, one male and one female, except that children under the age of 12 who are not part of the crew shall also be allowed aboard.
- 2.3 At least two boats in a division must be in the starting area for that division to be given a warning signal.
- 2.4 Eligible boats may register by completing the 2009 Regatta Entry Form and presenting it to the Santa Cruz Yacht Club as specified in 3.1
- 2.5 A boat is not entered until the entry form is signed and the entry fee is paid.

3 Fees

- 3.1 Entry fees are payable to the Santa Cruz Yacht Club. Early entries (\$25) are due at SCYC by 1800 September 18, 2009. Regular entries (\$30) will be accepted at the SCYC Club House between 1000 and 1055 hours on September 20, 2009.

4 Schedule

- 4.1 A competitors meeting will be at 1100 hours on September 20, 2009 at the SCYC club house.
- 4.2 The scheduled time of the first warning signal is 1255 hours.
- 4.3 One race is scheduled.
- 4.4 One race will constitute a series.
- 4.5 There will be an awards ceremony at the SCYC clubhouse following the regatta.

5 Sailing Instructions

- 5.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available at the competitors meeting.

6 Venue

- 6.1 Racing will be around temporary inflatable buoys or fixed buoys in Monterey Bay. The racing area will be within a 2.5 mile radius of the Santa Cruz Small Craft Harbor west jetty.

7 Courses

- 7.1 Courses will be distributed with the sailing instructions.

8 Prizes

- 8.1 Boats entered in classes with three (3) or more entries in the regatta are eligible for prizes or the Champion of Champions Regatta. Prizes will be given at the discretion of the organizing authority.
