**NOTICE OF RACE**

**2009 GRACE T. VEEDER CUP REGATTA  
AUGUST 29<sup>TH</sup> AND 30<sup>TH</sup>, 2009**

**1 Rules**

- 1.1 The series will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) including Appendix C (Match Racing Rules), the 2008-2009 SCYC Minimum Equipment Requirements (MER) as they apply to category 4 races and the Grace T. Veeder Cup Deed of Trust. The MER document may be found at [www.scyc.org](http://www.scyc.org) under "Racing".
- 1.2 RRS 40 will be changed to require competitors wear a personal flotation device while racing regardless of whether or not a "Y" flag is flown.
- 1.3 The Race Committee will abandon any race with no single winning boat. This changes RRS 32.1.
- 1.4 This is a one design event to be held in Santana 22 class yachts. Under Santana 22 class rules, no genoas or spinnakers are to be used.
- 1.5 RRS 27.3 is modified as per 4.5 below.

**2 Eligibility and Entry**

- 2.1 This match racing series will be contested between the two Santana 22 class yachts named by Monterey Peninsula Yacht Club and Santa Cruz Yacht Club as Challenger and Defender, respectively, in accordance with the Grace T. Veeder Cup Deed of Trust
- 2.2 There is no fee for this event.

**3 Notices to Competitors**

- 3.1 Notices to Competitors will be posted on the Official Notice Board located in the window of the northeast corner of the SCYC clubhouse.

**4 Schedule**

- 4.1 A competitors meeting will be at 1000 hours on August 29, 2009 at the SCYC club house. Determination of line end assignments for the first race will be determined by a coin toss at the competitors meeting.
- 4.2 Yachts may be inspected at 1030 hours.
- 4.3 The scheduled time of the first attention signal is 1220 hours each race day.
- 4.4 Five races are scheduled as follows:

August 29, 2009	3 races
August 30, 2009	2 races
- 4.5 This is a best of five series. The first yacht to win three races wins the series.
- 4.6 If a yacht loses the first two races on August 29th, she may request that the third race be postponed until August 30<sup>th</sup>. The procedure for doing this shall be specified in the Sailing Instructions. This changes RRS 27.3.

**5 Sailing Instructions**

- 5.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available at the competitors meeting.

**6 Venue and Courses**

- 6.1 Racing will be around temporary inflatable buoys in the north end of Monterey Bay. The racing area will be within a 2.5 mile radius from the Santa Cruz Small Craft Harbor west jetty.
- 6.2 Course diagrams will be provided with the sailing instructions.
